

Pharmacy Residency - PGY1 Pharmacy Residency

The Cleveland VA Medical Center is a multi-unit medical complex and is one of the largest VA facilities in the country and is affiliated with Case Western Reserve University. The primary residency site is the Wade Park Unit and is located about 6 miles east of Cleveland. The residency focuses on the development of a solid, well rounded knowledge base with the flexibility to gain experience in more specialized areas. Upon completion of this residency, the resident will be qualified to assume a clinical pharmacy position in adult medicine or go on to a specialty PGY-2 pharmacy residency position.
