

Cleveland VA Fisher House

A home away from home

The Fisher House provides free, temporary lodging to families and caregiver of military service members and Veterans so they can be close to their loved ones during a medical crisis, procedure or extended treatment.

Veterans and service members do not have to be receiving treatment at a VA facility to be eligible.

The Cleveland VA Fisher House is comprised of two 16-suite homes that provide a comforting, first-class experience to family member and caregivers while their loved one is receiving care in an unfamiliar environment.

We encourage all Veterans who are receiving treatment in the Cleveland area and live more than 50 miles away to talk to their provider about the Fisher House.



Providers play a key role in helping patients access the Fisher House's services. VA providers initiate the process by entering a CPRS consult. Non-VA providers contact the Fisher House manager.
