- The Peer Visitor Program (PVP) is a dynamic one which involves availability of peer visitors who provide support to persons with new amputation(s). The PVP consists of a pool of Veterans with amputation(s) who have been Certified as Peer Visitors. Certified Peer Visitors (CPV) are sensitive listeners who use their communication skills to facilitate self-recovery and self-exploration so the Veteran with a new amputation can make good decisions for themselves.
